## Reform of the European Union's system of own resources



Exchange of views
Rapporteur: Mercedes Bresso (S&D)

In her opinion, Ms Bresso is underlining some fundamental problems that exist in the current system of own resources. She is concerned that the current rules are against the Treaty provisions in that the Union budget is not financed from own resources and in that the Union commits to expenditure without having first ensured that it can be financed within the limit of the own resources available.

The Rapporteur also recalled the need to switch from unanimity to QMV voting for the adoption of own resources, thus putting Parliament on an equal footing with the Council when it comes to decision-making on both the revenue and expenditure sides of the EU budget.

She also acknowledged the opportunity that Brexit is creating to reconsider the current system of rebates and corrections and underlined that the system of own resources should be comprehensible to citizens.

The Rapporteur also noted that all of the scenarios presented by the Commission on the future of Europe would necessitate additional financing for the new priorities of the Union derived from genuine own resources.
